Daiwik Hotels plans 4-star hotel at Dwarka

Kolkata, Jan. 29

Kolkata-based Daiwik Hotels plans to set up a 4-star hotel at Dwarka (Gujarat). This is the company's third property in the country after Rameshwaram (Tamil Nadu) and Tirupati (Andhra Pradesh). A greenfield project at an expected investment of Rs 45 crore, the hotel is set to be operational by 2015. It will have around 120-140 rooms. According to a release, the company has already entered into a joint-venture with the Pabubha Manek family. The JV partner will provide a land bank of approximately 1.20 acre and the necessary infrastructure for the upcoming property. Daiwik Hotels operates in the pilgrim destination category with 4-star offerings. Plans are afoot to have presence in other pilgrim spots such as Somnath (Gujarat) and Ambaji (Gujarat). Currently, the hotel's Rameshwaram property is operational. — **Our Bureau**
